Child Nutrition Programs

The Division of Food and Nutrition has oversight for 8 Federal Child Nutrition Programs:

- **School Nutrition Programs:**
 - National School Lunch Program
 - School Breakfast Program
 - After School Snack Program
 - Special Milk Program
 - Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program
- Child and Adult Care Food Program
- Outside School Hours and At Risk Meals
- Summer Food Service Program





Federal Regulations

- Nutritious meals
- Meal components
- Food quantities
- *Reimbursed per meal
- **❖** USDA Foods
- Reimbursement can only be used to support the program
- Reimbursement is intended to supplement the cost of providing meal (food, labor, etc.)

Pennsylvania Numbers

Only 20% of the eligible children reached







Sponsors

- Are non-profit organizations
- Must have 501(c)3 status
- Work directly with PDE

Sites

- Locations where the meals are served
- Determines the type of eligibility
- Works with the sponsor





Sponsor's Responsibilities

Find the sites

Staff the sites

Find the volunteers

Train the staff and volunteers

Arrange for the meals

Maintain the paperwork

File for reimbursement

Complete annual training





<u>Site</u>

- Open
- Enrolled
- Camps





<u>Flexibility</u>

- Participate 1 day to 10 weeks
- Participate 1 day a week up to 7 days a week
- Serve hot or cold meals

Serve breakfast, lunch, supper or snacks (pick 2)
 Note, lunch OR dinner, but not both.

Website:

- Creates SFSP site locations and site information
- Authorizes access for EZ Meal Tracker users
- Provides site reporting details
 - Daily Site meal counts
 - Daily meal summary
 - Monthly meals served







Website and App for SFSP Meal Counting and Claiming

App:

- 1. Provides site and serving information
- 2. Logs meal delivery time, temp, meals received
- 3. Meal counter for 1st, 2nd and adult meals
- 4. Displays the meals served, prompts the user for the meal disposed, and calculates the Meals Left Over
- 5. SAVE sends information to Sponsor website






Pennsylvania Electronic Application Reimbursement System
